### **3 Eliminated Software Bugs**

#### **3.1 Behavior of Deleting a Project**

At the deletion of a project there is an option to remove all project files from hard disk. Up to now all files displayed in the project tree were deleted excluding the ones shown below folder "External Dependencies" containing all files inserted to the project by an "#include" statement. If a file was inserted by an "Add Files" or "Add Files to Project" command, then it was deleted by "Delete Project" command with active option "Remove file from harddisk", even when it was located outside the project directory. This behavior was the same since the introduction of this option. As a consequence there was the possibility that global and shared files could accidently be removed from the hard disk in case there were not inserted by a "#include" statement. Therefore from this version onwards only those JetSym files of a project located outside its directory are removed.
